

# Foreign investors boost Dar bourse

**Dar es Salaam.** Turnover at the Dar es Salaam Stock Exchange (DSE) rose by 77.87 percent last week on the back of a return by foreign investors.

A total of Sh1.7 billion in weekly turnover was registered last week compared to the Sh956.63 million recorded in the preceding week, market data shows.

Tanzania Breweries Ltd

(TBL) dominated the market - recording 71.22 percent of the total turnover - followed by Tanzania Cigarette Co. (TCC) with 23.79 percent.

Tuesday last week foreigners bought a block of 242,386 TBL

shares valued at Sh1.21 billion through a pre-arranged market board.

"We expect the trend to continue next week," Zan Securities Ltd's chief executive officer Raphael Masumbuko, said.
